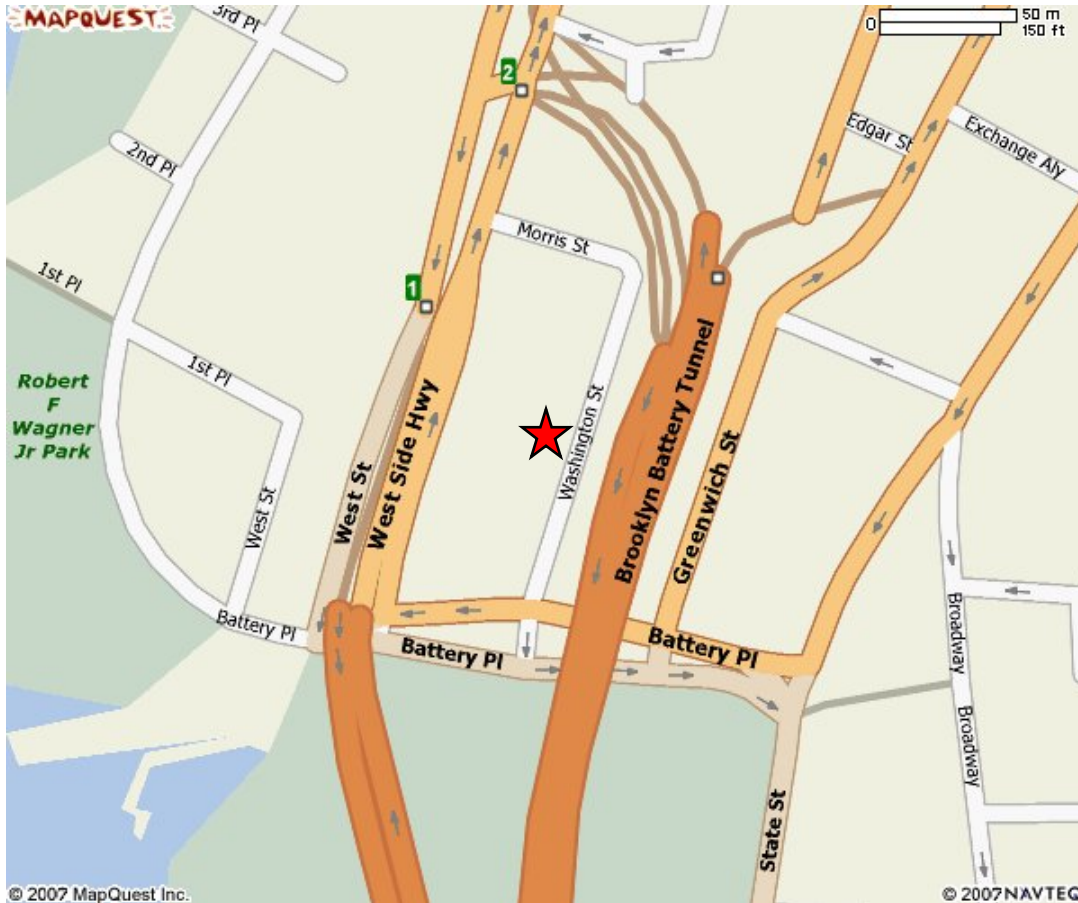


**Directions to NYIF Downtown Campus  
17 Battery Place – North Tower, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor  
(Entrance at 2-26 Washington Street)**



**4 and 5 Subway Line**

Take the 4 or 5 train to Bowling Green. Upon exiting the train, go down the stairs toward the 4/5 Uptown platform and take the Battery Place-Broadway exit. Go up the escalator. Take the Greenwich Street exit, which lets you out on Battery Place (right in front of the National Museum of the American Indian). Walk two blocks west (toward the water) along Battery Place. Turn right onto Washington Street and enter at 2-26 Washington Street. Take the first elevator bank to the sixth floor.

**R and W Subway Line**

Take the R or W to Whitehall Street/South Ferry and take the Stone Street exit (toward the rear of the train). Walk north (past Chipotle and Starbucks) approximately one block to Bowling Green. Make a left on Bowling Green (onto the cobblestones) and walk one block west (past the National Museum of the American Indian) until you come to the beginning of Battery Place. Continue west along Battery Place for two blocks, to

Washington Street. (Due to construction, there may not be a street sign. Zaytuna is on the corner of Washington Street and Battery Place.) Turn right and enter at 2-26 Washington Street (which will be on the left side of the street). Take the first elevator bank to the sixth floor.

### **1, 2 & 3 Subway Lines**

Take the 1 to Rector Street. Use the exit closest to front of the train. At the top of the stairs, you will see a footbridge over the entrance to the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel. Cross the footbridge. (At the far end of the footbridge, you will see a building labeled “21 West Street.”) At the end of the footbridge, take the stairs to your left and walk south on Washington Street. Enter 2-26 Washington Street (right side of the street, past the Battery Park Café). Take the first elevator bank to the sixth floor.

### **E Subway Line**

Take the E to World Trade Center. Exit onto Church Street and head south. Church Street becomes Trinity Place; continue south on Trinity Place past Exchange Aly and Edgar Street. Upon approaching Morris Street, you will see a TGIFriday’s on your left and the Rector Street stop of the 1 Subway Line on your right. Just past this subway stop, on your right, will be a footbridge over the entrance to the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel. Cross the footbridge. (At the far end of the footbridge, you will see a building labeled “21 West Street.”) At the end of the footbridge, take the stairs to your left and walk south on Washington Street. Enter 2-26 Washington Street (right side of the street, past the Battery Park Café). Take the first elevator bank to the sixth floor.

### **Path Train from New Jersey**

Take the Path to World Trade Center. Exit onto Church Street and head south. Church Street becomes Trinity Place; continue south on Trinity Place past Exchange Aly and Edgar Street. Upon approaching Morris Street, you will see a TGIFriday’s on your left and the Rector Street stop of the 1 Subway Line on your right. Just past this subway stop, on your right, will be a footbridge over the entrance to the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel. Cross the footbridge. (At the far end of the footbridge, you will see a building labeled “21 West Street.”) At the end of the footbridge, take the stairs to your left and walk south on Washington Street. Enter 2-26 Washington Street (right side of the street, past the Battery Park Café). Take the first elevator bank to the sixth floor.

### **Ferry from New Jersey**

Take the ferry to World Financial Center. (Ferries to WFC can be boarded at Belford/Harbor Way, Hoboken/14<sup>th</sup> Street, Hoboken/NJ Transit Terminal Paulus Hook, or Port Imperial/Weehawken.) Walk out of Battery Park to Battery Place. 17 Battery Place is directly across street, between West Street and Washington Street. Walk along Washington Street and enter at 2-26. Take the first elevator bank to the sixth floor.

### **Lincoln and Holland Tunnels**

Go south on the West Side Highway (a.k.a. West Street). Look for signs for the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel. Stay on the right side of the highway so that you do not exit the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel or the underpass that takes you to the FDR Drive. Make a left

turn at the end of the highway onto Battery Place. Battery Park will be on your right. On your left, across the municipal parking lot, is 17 Battery Place.

### **Triborough Bridge/59th Street Bridge/Midtown Tunnel**

Take the FDR Drive south (downtown). Near the end of the drive you will see a sign Battery Park/Staten Island Ferry. Bear right onto the service road, which is South Street. After you cross Broad Street you will drive one block and then make a right turn. You are now on State Street. After one block, State Street turns left\* and after another long block curves right. (Battery Park will be on your left.) Continue on State Street crossing Pearl and Bridge Streets. Turn left on the next block, which is Battery Place. Drive three blocks west (toward the water) to 17 Battery Place.

\*If you are not permitted to make a left turn, drive straight ahead for one block on Whitehall Street. Make a left turn on Pearl Street and after one block a right turn which will bring you back on State Street. Cross Bridge Street. The next block is Battery Place.

### **Parking (Difficult and Expensive)**

- Edison Park Fast lot at the end of the West Side Highway to the right
- Limited time municipal parking front of 17 Battery Place
- Battery Park Garage
  - Edgar Street Entrance to Battery Park Garage – After Turning Left From the West Side Highway onto Battery Place, drive two blocks east until you come to Greenwich Street. Make a left turn and proceed for two more blocks until you come to Edgar Street. Make a left turn and drive one block. Battery Park Garage will be straight ahead.

**Or**

- Morris Street Entrance to Battery Park Garage – Travel west on Battery Place. Make a right turn on West Street. Travel one block north. Make a right turn on Morris Street. Battery Park Garage will be on your left.
